CALL FOR PAPERS (No 2)

The European Association of Chinese Teaching (EACT) is pleased to announce that its 5th International Symposium will be held at “L’Orientale” University of Naples (Italy), between the 2nd and the 4th of July 2025, **followed by a two-day academic and cultural visit programme (5th and 6th of July)**. EACT welcomes colleagues concerned with the learning and teaching of Chinese from all over the world to join us in-person to exchange ideas and research outcomes. The webpage for the conference will soon be available. **This is the 2nd Call for Papers with updates and extra information in red, mainly concerning: deadline extension, announcement of keynote speakers and of a special plenary session in honour of prof. Lü Bisong, updated committee.**

The Symposium is organized by the EACT in conjunction with “L’Orientale” University of Naples and its Confucius Institute. The theme of the Symposium is “Challenges and Opportunities for Chinese Language Teaching in a Rapidly Evolving European Society: new standards, multilingual environments and emerging technologies”. This 5th International Symposium will focus on exploring the challenges and opportunities Chinese language education faces today, together with the future trends, based upon the past and particularly recent developments in schools and in higher education institutions in Europe and elsewhere. Special attention will be given to:



1. The development of Teaching Chinese as a Foreign Language as an academic discipline

2. EBCL 2 (European Benchmarks for the Chinese language 2) project, which is drafting the descriptors for levels B1-C1 for European competences of Chinese language;

3. Theories, practices and new tools for teaching Chinese taking into consideration the learners' L1 and cultural specificities;

4. Chinese language teaching through AI, apps, platforms, programs, websites, etc.

As 2025 is the 90th birthday of Prof. LÜ Bisong (吕必松), one of the founders of Teaching Chinese as a Foreign Language as an academic discipline, a special plenary session will be held at this symposium in his honour. During the symposium, the EACT will also hold its General Assembly. All the members are welcome to attend.

DATE, VENUE AND WORKING LANGUAGES

2nd to the 4th of July 2025 at “L’Orientale” University of Naples, Italy. Presentations can be either in Chinese or English, exclusively in presence.

5th and 6th of July academic and cultural program: visit of Naples city and University, and of the beautiful surrounding areas. Details to follow soon.

MAIN THEMES OF THE SYMPOSIUM INCLUDE:

1. History of Chinese language teaching
2. Chinese language teaching and learning policy in different national education systems



3. Chinese language standards and benchmarks across Europe and elsewhere
4. Research and development of Chinese language education syllabus in home countries
5. Development, publication of Chinese language teaching materials and research in Europe and beyond
6. Research on learners of Chinese, such as their background, motivation and implications for and impact on Chinese learning and teaching
7. Chinese heritage language learners in Europe
8. Chinese language teacher training and professional development in different countries
9. Teaching, learning, assessing Chinese language competences through the use of new technological tools: apps, platforms, web resources, AI, etc.
10. Other relevant fields concerning the learning and teaching of Chinese language

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION AND REQUIREMENTS:

1. The abstract should include the following information: field, two to three keywords and the actual abstract. The abstract can be in either Chinese or English, approximately 300 words in Chinese or about 400 words in English.
2. Each person can submit only one abstract as an independent or first author. It is possible to submit one other abstract as a co-author.

Please note that no other means of submissions will be accepted for this symposium.

4. Information on registration and payment will follow after abstract acceptance confirmation.

Deadline for paper presenters to confirm participation and register online: 30th April, 2025

The Symposium has an academic/scientific committee responsible for the organization of blind peer review of all the submitted abstracts. The authors of the accepted abstract will have a 20-minute slot to present their paper, including Q&A, in the relevant panels.

欧洲汉语教学协会 (EACT) 第五届研讨会将于2025年7月2日至4日在意大利那不勒斯“东方”大学举行。7月5日至6日将进行两天的游学与文化访问活动。EACT诚邀全球关注汉语学习与教学的学者齐聚一堂，现场交流思想和研究成果。会议网页将很快上线。此为第二号征文通知。红色部分包含最新与补充信息，主要涉及：截止日期延期、主旨发言人、委员会更新，以及向吕必松教授致敬的特别全体会议安排。

本次研讨会由EACT与那不勒斯“东方”大学及其孔子学院联合举办。本次研讨会的主题是“快速发展的欧洲社会汉语教学的挑战与机遇：新标准、多语言环境和新兴技术”。

第五届国际研讨会将根据欧洲和其他地区学校和高等教育机构过去和特别是最近的发展，重点探讨汉语教育当今面临的挑战和机遇以及未来趋势。将特别关注：

1. 对外汉语教学及其作为学术学科的构建。
2. 《欧洲汉语能力标准》二期项目 (“欧标2” ; EBCL 2), 正在起草欧洲汉语能力B1-C1级别描述符。
3. 考虑学习者的母语和文化特殊性的汉语教学理论、实践和新工具。
4. 通过人工智能、应用程序、平台、程序、网站等进行汉语教学。



由于 2025 年是吕必松教授——对外汉语教学作为学术学科的奠基人之一——的 90 岁生日，本次研讨会将特别举行一场全体会议以表彰他的重要贡献。本届会议期间也将举行欧洲汉语教学协会的全体会员大会，敬请所有会员届时踊跃参加。

论文摘要提交要求

1. 论文摘要需包括议题、题目、2-3个关键词和摘要正文。摘要用中、英文均可，中文字数在300字左右，英文400词左右。
2. 每人作为独立作者或第一作者只可提交一篇论文摘要，同时还可作为非第一作者合作提交另一篇摘要。
